

Board Name Change

AB 1431, effective January 1, 2011, changes the Board name to the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists. In preparation for the name change, Board staff have been working diligently to transition to the new name.

DCA is working with the Employment Development Department to create mock-ups of the new renewal notices, licenses, and certificates for our approval.

We have arranged with building management for new lobby and suite signs to go up on the effective date of the name change. Our business services officer, Vicki Kereszt, is ordering new return address stamps, embossing seals, and seal stamps.

Website changes will be made and the official letterhead and board logo will be updated. All forms, applications, etc. must be updated to include the new name.

In support of the Board's green and recycling efforts, both the Geology program and the Engineering/Land Surveying side will continue to use our pre-printed envelopes until they are depleted. It is estimated that we have a 12-18 month supply.

New business cards will be ordered for the Board members, EO, and AEO. Board staff will continue to use their current business cards until depleted.
