**RELEASE OF FALL 2013 EXAMINATION RESULTS****UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL RESULTS BE PROVIDED BY TELEPHONE**

All Professional Engineer and Professional Land Surveyor examination results were mailed by December 20, 2013.

All Professional Geologist (PG), Geologist-In-Training (GIT), Certified Engineering Geologist (CEG), and Certified Hydrogeologist (CHG), examination(s) results were mailed on December 23, 2013.

Result letters are sent through the United States Postal Service. Please do not request a duplicate result letter unless you have not received the original result letter by December 31, 2013.

The result letters are mailed to the candidate at his or her address of record. If you have changed your address of record since the examination and you have not yet notified the Board directly, you need to complete the online Address Change Request Form (available on the Board's web site). Submitting a change of address or forwarding request to the U.S. Postal Service is not sufficient; you must notify the Board directly.

Examination Review and Appeals

By law, examination review and appeals are **ONLY** available for the Certified Engineering Geologist (CEG), Certified Hydrogeologist (CHG), and Professional Geophysicist (PGp) examinations. Appeals for the CEG, CHG, and PGp examinations require that you score within 10% of the passing scores. If you qualify for an appeal, your result notice will indicate the date that appeals will be held and how to schedule your review and appeal.

Applicants Who Failed One or More Examination(s)

Applicants who took and failed one or more examinations in Fall 2013 can submit a refile application. Refile applications for all Spring 2014 examinations must be postmarked by **January 6, 2014**.

Applicants Who Failed to Appear for One or More Examination(s)

Applicants who did not take one or more examinations for which they were scheduled and do not have an approved "Request for Postponement" for the examination(s) in question, will be required to submit a new application for future examination(s), including all application and examination fees, by the scheduled final filing date for the examination they wish to take.
