You have been identified as an interested party in regards to the recently released Alquist-Priolo Earthquake Fault Zoning Act (A-P) preliminary maps for the Azusa and Hollywood Quadrangles, and upcoming public hearings. The purpose of the public hearings is to provide an opportunity for interested parties to present oral and written technical comments that may have a bearing on the proposed zone maps to the SMGB during the 90-day public comment period which commenced on January 8 and terminates on April 8, 2014.

The State Mining and Geology Board (SMGB) Geohazards Committee will hold a public hearing on the preliminary Azusa Quadrangle A-P map on March 12, 2014, in the City of Azusa. The SMGB will hold a public hearing on the preliminary A-P Hollywood Quadrangle map on March 13, 2014, in the City of Los Angeles.
