JURISDICTION

- 3. On or about December 17, 2014, the Board issued Civil Engineer License No. C 83137 to Jon-Barrett Havrilesko (Respondent). The Civil Engineer License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 1276-A and will expire on March 31, 2023, unless renewed.
- 4. Accusation No. 1276-A was filed before the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists (Board), Department of Consumer Affairs and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on March 22, 2022. Respondent timely filed his Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy of Accusation No. 1276-A is attached as exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

- Respondent has carefully read, and understands the charges and allegations in
 Accusation No. 1276-A. Respondent has also carefully read, and understands the effects of this
 Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval.
- 6. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel at his own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to present evidence and to testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
- 7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and every right set forth above.

CULPABILITY

8. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation No. 1276-A.

9. Respondent agrees that his Civil Engineer License is subject to discipline and he agrees to be bound by the Disciplinary Order below.

CONTINGENCY

- 10. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to or participation by Respondent. By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- 11. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval, including PDF and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 12. This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.
- 13. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Disciplinary Order:

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DISCIPLINARY ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Civil Engineer License No. C 83137 issued to Respondent Jon-Barrett Havrilesko (Respondent) shall be publicly reproved by the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists under Business and Professions Code section 495 in resolution of Accusation No. 1276-A, attached as exhibit A.

- 1. Within ninety (90) days from the effective date of the decision, Respondent shall reimburse the Board for its investigative and enforcement costs in this matter in the amount of \$1,677.50. If Respondent fails to pay the Board costs as ordered, Respondent shall not be allowed to renew his Civil Engineer License until Respondent pays the costs in full. In addition, the Board may enforce this order for payment of its costs in any appropriate court, in addition to any other rights the Board may have.
- 2. Within thirty (30) days from the effective date of the decision, Respondent shall fully comply with the Order of Abatement and Order to Pay Administrative Fine as contained in Citation Order 10883-L by paying the administrative fine of \$250.00 and by responding to the complaint investigation identified in the Citation.
- 3. If Respondent fails to satisfy the aforementioned conditions, the Accusation shall be reinstated, and all allegations in the Accusation shall be deemed admitted by Respondent. Under such circumstances, the Board shall be permitted, notwithstanding any statute or law to the contrary, to proceed on the Accusation and impose discipline under any or all of the causes for discipline in the Accusation without having to prove any conduct other than Respondent's failure to comply with this Order. As a resolution of the charges in Accusation No. 1276-A, this stipulated settlement is contingent upon Respondent's full compliance with all conditions of this Order. If Respondent fails to satisfy any of these conditions, such failure to comply constitutes cause for discipline, including outright revocation, of Respondent's Civil Engineer License No. C 83137.

ACCEPTANCE
