PE Petroleum - The PE Petroleum exam will transition to computer-based testing in October 2019. This will be a single-day testing event similar to paper-based exam administrations and the PE Nuclear computer-based exam administration. The test date is Tuesday, October 15, 2019. Registration with NCEES for this exam began November 6, 2018. Examinees may reserve their seat at a Pearson VUE test center once they are registered with NCEES. The PE Nuclear exam will be offered on the same day.

PE Control Systems Engineering - The PE Control Systems Engineering exam has new specifications starting in October 2019. The specifications are posted on the NCEES website. <https://ncees.org/engineering/pe/control-systems/>

PE Mechanical - The PE Mechanical exam will have its last paper-and-pencil administration in October 2019. This exam will transition to CBT in April 2020 and be available year-round starting on April 1, 2020. Beginning November 4, 2019, examinees will be able to register and schedule CBT appointments.
