3. On or about May 21, 2012, Respondent was served by Certified and First Class Mail copies of the Accusation No. 989-A, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for Discovery, and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at Respondent's address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 136, is required to be reported and maintained with the Board. Respondent's address of record was and is:

817 De La Fuente Street Monterey Park, CA 91754.

- 4. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of Government Code section 11505, subdivision (c) and/or Business & Professions Code section 124.
- 5. On or about May 25, 2012, the aforementioned documents were returned by the U.S. Postal Service marked "Forwarding Address Expired." The address on the documents was the same as the address on file with the Board. Respondent failed to maintain an updated address with the Board and the Board has made attempts to serve the Respondent at the address on file. Respondent has not made himself available for service and therefore, has not availed himself of his right to file a notice of defense and appear at hearing.
 - 6. Government Code section 11506 states, in pertinent part:
 - (c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent files a notice of defense, and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts of the accusation not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense shall constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.
- 7. Respondent failed to file a Notice of Defense within 15 days after service upon him of the Accusation, and therefore waived his right to a hearing on the merits of Accusation No. 989-A.
 - 8. California Government Code section 11520 states, in pertinent part:
 - (a) If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense or to appear at the hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express admissions or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to respondent.

- 9. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Board finds Respondent is in default. The Board will take action without further hearing and, based on the relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Evidence Packet in this matter, as well as taking official notice of all the investigatory reports, exhibits and statements contained therein on file at the Board's offices regarding the allegations contained in Accusation No. 989-A, finds that the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 989-A, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.
- 10. Taking official notice of its own internal records, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3, it is hereby determined that the reasonable costs for Investigation and Enforcement is \$22,081.25 as of August 8, 2012.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

- Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent Chee Sen Lee has subjected his Civil Engineer License No. C 28034 to discipline.
 - 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default.
- 3. The Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists is authorized to revoke Respondent's Civil Engineer License based upon the following violations alleged in the Accusation which are supported by the evidence contained in the Default Decision Evidence Packet in this case:
- a. Respondent failed to file a Record of Survey or Corner Record for forty-four (44) different properties in violation of Business and Professions Code section 8780, subdivision (d), in conjunction with section 8762, subdivisions (b) and (c).
- b. Respondent aided and abetted the unlicensed practice of land surveying in violation of Business and Professions Code section 8780, subdivision (f), in conjunction with section 8792, subdivision (a).
- c. Respondent failed to file or have on file with the board an organization record form for his business in violation of Business and Professions Code section 8780, subdivision (d), in conjunction with section 8729, subdivision (i).

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1	d. Respondent failed to notify the Board within thirty (30) days of a change of address
2	in violation of Title 16, California Code of Regulations section 412.
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4	ORDER
5	IT IS SO ORDERED that Civil Engineer License No. C 28034, heretofore issued to
6	Respondent Chee Sen Lee, is revoked.
7	Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a
8	written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within
9	seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may
10	vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.
11	This Decision shall become effective on October 5, 2012

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JURISDICTION

3. This Accusation is brought before the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists (Board), Department of Consumer Affairs, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the Business and Professions Code unless otherwise indicated.

STATUTORY PROVISIONS

- 4. Section 118, subdivision (b), of the Code provides that the expiration of a license shall not deprive the Board of jurisdiction to proceed with a disciplinary action during the period within which the license may be renewed, restored, reissued or reinstated.
 - 5. Section 8780 states:

"The board may receive and investigate complaints against licensed land surveyors and registered civil engineers, and make findings thereon.

"By a majority vote, the board may reprove, suspend for a period not to exceed two years, or revoke the license or certificate of any licensed land surveyor or registered civil engineer, respectively, licensed under this chapter or registered under the provisions of Chapter 7 (commencing with Section 6700), whom it finds to be guilty of:

"(d) Any violation of any provision of this chapter [chapter 15, commencing with section 8700] or of any other law relating to or involving the practice of land surveying.

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"(f) Aiding or abetting any person in the violation of any provision of this chapter.

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- "(h) A violation in the course of the practice of land surveying of a rule or regulation of unprofessional conduct adopted by the board."
- 2425
- Section 8792 states:

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"Every person is guilty of a misdemeanor:

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- "(a) Who, unless he or she is exempt from licensing under this chapter, practices, or offers to practice, land surveying in this state without legal authorization."
- "(b) Who presents as his or her own the license of a professional land surveyor unless he or she is the person named on the license."

7. Section 8762 states:

- "(b) After making a field survey in conformity with the practice of land surveying, the licensed land surveyor or licensed civil engineer shall file with the county surveyor in the county in which the field survey was made a record of the survey relating to land boundaries or property lines, if the field survey discloses any of the following:
- "(1) Material evidence or physical change, which in whole or in part does not appear on any subdivision map, official map, or record of survey previously recorded or properly filed in the office of the county recorder or county surveying department, or map or survey record maintained by the Bureau of Land Management of the United States.
- "(2) A material discrepancy with the information contained in any subdivision map, official map, or record of survey previously recorded or filed in the office of the county recorder or the county surveying department, or any map or survey record maintained by the Bureau of Land Management of the United States. For purposes of this subdivision, a "material discrepancy" is limited to a material discrepancy in the position of points or lines, or in dimensions.
- "(3) Evidence that, by reasonable analysis, might result in materially alternate positions of lines or points, shown on any subdivision map, official map, or record of survey previously recorded or filed in the office of the county recorder or the county surveying department, or any map or survey record maintained by the Bureau of Land Management of the United States.
- "(4) The establishment of one or more points or lines not shown on any subdivision map, official map, or record of survey, the positions of which are not ascertainable from an inspection of the subdivision map, official map, or record of survey.
- "(5) The points or lines set during the performance of a field survey of any parcel described in any deed or other instrument of title recorded in the county recorder's office are not shown on any subdivision map, official map, or record of survey.

"(c) The record of survey required to be filed pursuant to this section shall be filed within 90 days after the setting of boundary monuments during the performance of a field survey or within 90 days after the completion of a field survey, whichever occurs first.

REGULATORY PROVISIONS

8. Title 16, California Code of Regulations section 412 states:

"Each person who is an applicant for, or a holder of, a certificate or license issued by the Board under provisions of the Professional Engineers Act or the Professional Land Surveyors' Act shall file his/her address with the Board office. Within thirty (30) days after changing addresses, he/she shall notify the Board office of such change."

COST RECOVERY

9. Section 125.3 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Failure to File a Record of Survey or Corner Record)

- 10. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under section 8780 (d), in conjunction with section 8762, subdivisions (b) and (c), in that Respondent conducted surveys and set monuments but failed to file a Record of Survey or Corner Record for forty (44) different properties. These properties are as follows:
