2	9. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation

4	10. Respondent agrees that his Civil Engineer License is subject to discipline and he	
5	agrees to be bound by the Board's probationary terms as set forth in the Disciplinary Order below.	
6	<u>CONTINGENCY</u>	
7	11. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board for Professional Engineers,	
8	Land Surveyors, and Geologists. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for	
9	Complainant and the staff of the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and	
10	Geologists may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and settlement,

In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that 1 14. 2 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following **Disciplinary Order:** 3 **DISCIPLINARY ORDER** 4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Civil Engineer License No. C 64685 issued to Respondent 5 Brandon Dong Le is revoked. However, the revocation is stayed and Respondent is placed on 6 probation for two (2) years on the following terms and conditions: 7 1. Obey All Laws. The Respondent shall obey all laws and regulations related to the 8 9 practices of professional engineering and professional land surveying. Comply with Citation. Within thirty days of the effective date of this decision, 10 2. Respondent shall comply with Citation Order No. 10715-L, issued on or about November 27, 11 2018, including but not limited to, within thirty day of the effective date of this decision, submit a 12 written response to the Board's Enforcement Unit's inquiries regarding the complaint filed 13 14 against Respondent (Case No. 2018-04-094) and pay the administrative fine of \$500.00. 3. Submit Reports. The Respondent shall submit such special reports as the Board may 15 require. 16 4. **Tolling of Probation.** The period of probation shall be tolled during the time the 17 Respondent is practicing exclusively outside the state of California. If, during the period of 18 probation, the Respondent practices exclusively outside the state of California, the Respondent 19 shall immediately notify the Board in writing. 205. Violation of Probation. If the Respondent violates the probationary conditions in 21 any respect, the Board, after giving the Respondent notice and the opportunity to be heard, may 22 vacate the stay and reinstate the disciplinary order which was stayed. If, during the period of 23 24 probation, an accusation or petition to vacate stay is filed against the Respondent, or if the matter has been submitted to the Office of the Attorney General for the filing of such, the Board shall 25 have continuing jurisdiction until all matters are final, and the period of probation shall be 26 extended until all matters are final. 27 ///// 28 4

6. Completion of Probation. Upon successful completion of all of the probationary conditions and the expiration of the period of probation, the Respondent's license shall be unconditionally restored.

7. Cost Recovery. Respondent is hereby ordered to reimburse the Board the amount of
\$1,500.00 within one year from the effective date of this decision for its investigative and
prosecution costs. Failure to reimburse the Board's cost of its investigation and prosecution shall
constitute a violation of the probation order, unless the Board agrees in writing to payment by an
installment plan because of financial hardship.

8. Examination. Within 60 days of the effective date of the decision, the Respondent
shall successfully complete and pass the California Laws and Board Rules examination, as
administered by the Board.

Section 118, subdivision (b) states:

"(b) The suspension, expiration, or forfeiture by operation of law of a license issued by a 4 5 board in the department, or its suspension, forfeiture, or cancellation by order of the board or by order of a court of law, or its surrender without the written consent of the board, shall not, during 6 any period in which it may be renewed, restored, reissued, or reinstated, deprive the board of its 7 8 authority to institute or continue a disciplinary proceeding against the licensee upon any ground 9 provided by law or to enter an order suspending or revoking the license or otherwise taking 10 disciplinary action against the licensee on any such ground."

5. Section 6796 states:

"Except as otherwise provided in this article, certificates of registration as a professional 12 engineer and certificates of authority may be renewed at any time within five years after 13 14 expiration on filing of application for renewal on a form prescribed by the board and payment of all accrued and unpaid renewal fees. If the certificate is renewed more than 60 days after its 15 expiration, the certificate holder, as a condition precedent to renewal, shall also pay the 16 delinquency fee prescribed by this chapter. Renewal under this section shall be effective on the 17 date on which the application is filed, on the date on which the renewal fee is paid, or on the date 18 19 on which the delinquency fee, if any, is paid, whichever last occurs.

"The expiration date of a certificate renewed pursuant to this section shall be determined 20 pursuant to Section 6795." 21

STATUTORY AND REGULATORY PROVISIONS

6. Section 125.9 states, in part:

24 "(a) Except with respect to persons regulated under Chapter 11 (commencing with Section 7500), any board, bureau, or commission within the department, the State Board of Chiropractic 25 Examiners, and the Osteopathic Medical Board of California, may establish, by regulation, a 26 system for the issuance to a licensee of a citation which may contain an order of abatement or an 27

1	order to pay an administrative fine assessed by the board, bureau, or commission where the	
2	licensee is in violation of the applicable licensing act or any regulation adopted pursuant thereto.	
3	"(b) The system shall contain the following provisions:	
4		
5	"(5) Failure of a licensee to pay a fine within 30 days of the date of assessment, unless the	
6	citation is being appealed, may result in disciplinary action being taken by the board, bureau, or	
7	commission. Where a citation is not contested and a fine is not paid, the full amount of the	
8	assessed fine shall be added to the fee for renewal of the license. A license shall not be renewed	
9	without payment of the renewal fee and fine.	
10	"	
11	7. Section 6775, subdivision (h) states:	
12	"The board may, upon its own initiative or upon the receipt of a complaint, investigate the	
13	actions of any professional engineer licensed under this chapter and make findings thereon.	
14	"By a majority vote, the board may publicly reprove, suspend for a period not to exceed	
15	two years, or revoke the certificate of any professional engineer licensed under this chapter on	
16	any of the following grounds:	
17		
18	"(h) A violation of any provision of this chapter or any other law relating to or involving	
19	the practice of professional engineering."	
20	8. California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 473.3, subdivision (b) states:	
21	"(b) Failure of the cited person to abate the violation or to pay all of the assessed fine within	
22	the time allowed is grounds for suspension or revocation of the cited person's license."	
23	COST RECOVERY	
24	9. Business and Professions Code section 125.3 provides, in part, that the Board may	
25	request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or	
26	violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation	
27	and enforcement of the case, with failure of the licentiate to comply subjecting the license to not

12	became final, to pay the Board an administrative fine in the amount of \$500.00.	
13	b. A citation order directing Respondent, within thirty days of the date the citation	
14	became final, to submit a written response to inquiries the Board's Enforcement Unit had	
15	previously sent to Respondent regarding a complaint the Board had received regarding	
16	Respondent.

18	11. To determine the degree of discipline, if any, to be imposed on Respondent,	
19	Complainant alleges that on or about November 27, 2018, in a prior action, the Board issued
