STIPULATED SETTLEMENT AND
DISCIPLINARY ORDER FOR PUBLIC
REPROVAL

[Bus. & Prof. Code § 495]

21 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-
22 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

23 **PARTIES**

24 1. Richard B. Moore, PLS (Complainant) is the Executive Officer of the Board for
25 Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists (Board). He brought this action solely in
26 his official capacity and is represented in this matter by Rob Bonta, Attorney General of the State
27 of California, by Aspasia A. Papavassiliou, Deputy Attorney General.
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2. Respondent Steven Richard Bond (Respondent) is represented in this proceeding by attorney Jacob G. Reinhardt whose address is: Gould, Hahn, & Reinhardt PLC, 2550 Ninth Street, Suite 101, Berkeley, CA 94710-2551

JURISDICTION

3. On or about June 2, 1992, the Board issued Professional Geologist License No. 5411 to Steven Richard Bond (Respondent). The Professional Geologist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 1294-A and will expire on February 28, 2026, unless renewed.

4. On or about September 1, 1993, the Board issued Certified Engineering Geologist License Number 1843 to Respondent. The Certified Engineering Geologist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 1294-A and will expire on February 28, 2026, unless renewed.

5. On or about September 29, 1995, the Board issued Certified Hydrogeologist License Number 238 to Respondent. The Certified Hydrogeologist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 1294-A and will expire on February 28, 2026, unless renewed.

6. Accusation No. 1294-A was filed before the Board and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on June 29, 2023. Respondent timely filed his Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy of Accusation No. 1294-A is attached as exhibit A and incorporated here by reference.

ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

7. Respondent has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 1294-A. Respondent has also carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval.

8. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel at

1 his own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to
2 present evidence and to testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel
3 the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and
4 court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California
5 Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.

6 9. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and
7 every right set forth above.

8 **CULPABILITY**

9 10. Respondent understands and agrees that the charges and allegations in Accusation
10 No. 1294-A, if proven at a hearing, constitute cause for imposing discipline upon his Professional
11 Geologist License, Certified Engineering Geologist License and Certified Hydrogeologist
12 License.

13 11. For the purpose of resolving the Accusation without the expense and uncertainty of
14 further proceedings, Respondent agrees that, at a hearing, Complainant could establish a factual
15 basis for the charges in the Accusation, and that Respondent hereby gives up his right to contest
16 those charges.

17 12. Respondent agrees that his Professional Geologist License, Certified Engineering
18 Geologist License and Certified Hydrogeologist License are subject to discipline and he agrees to
19 be bound by the Disciplinary Order below.

20 **CONTINGENCY**

21 13. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board for Professional Engineers,
22 Land Surveyors, and Geologists. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for
23 Complainant and the staff of the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and
24 Geologists may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and settlement,
25 without notice to or participation by Respondent or his counsel. By signing the stipulation,
26 Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the
27 stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this
28 stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public

1 Reproval shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any
2 legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by
3 having considered this matter.

4 14. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile
5 copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval, including PDF
6 and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

7 15. This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval is intended by
8 the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment
9 of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements,
10 understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated
11 Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval may not be altered, amended, modified,
12 supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative
13 of each of the parties.

14 16. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
15 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
16 Disciplinary Order:

17 **DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

18 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Professional Geologist License No. 5411, Certified
19 Engineering Geologist License No. 1843, and Certified Hydrogeologist License No. 238, issued
20 to Respondent Steven Richard Bond (Respondent), shall be publicly reprovod by the Board for
21 Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists under Business and Professions Code
22 section 495 in resolution of Accusation No. 1294-A, attached as exhibit A.

23 **Cost Recovery.** No later than ONE YEAR from the effective date of the Decision,
24 Respondent shall pay \$2,500.00 to the Board for its costs associated with the investigation and
25 enforcement of this matter pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 125.3. If
26 Respondent fails to pay the Board costs as ordered, Respondent shall not be allowed to renew his
27 Professional Geologist License until Respondent pays costs in full. In addition, the Board may
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1 enforce this order for payment of its costs in any appropriate court, in addition to any other rights
2 the Board may have.

3 **Full Compliance.** As a resolution of the charges in Accusation No. 1294-A, this stipulated
4 settlement is contingent upon Respondent's full compliance with all conditions of this Order. If
5 Respondent fails to satisfy any of these conditions, such failure to comply constitutes cause for
6 discipline, including outright revocation, of Respondent's Professional Geologist License No.
7 5411, Certified Engineering Geologist License No. 1843, and Certified Hydrogeologist License
8 No. 238.

9 **ACCEPTANCE**

10 I have carefully read the above Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public
11 Reprimand and have fully discussed it with my attorney, Jacob G. Reinhardt. I understand the
12 stipulation and the effect it will have on my Professional Geologist License, Certified
13 Engineering Geologist License, and Certified Hydrogeologist License. I enter into this Stipulated
14 Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reprimand voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently,
15 and agree to be bound by the Decision and Order of the Board for Professional Engineers, Land
16 Surveyors, and Geologists.

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22 **PARTIES**

23 1. Richard B. Moore, PLS (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in his official
24 capacity as the Executive Officer of the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and
25 Geologists , Department of Consumer Affairs.

26 2. On or about June 2, 1992, the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and
27 Geologists issued Professional Geologist License Number 5411 to Steven Richard Bond
28 (Respondent). The Professional Geologist License was in full force and effect at all times

relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation and will expire on February 29, 2024, unless renewed.

3. On or about September 1, 1993, the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists issued Certified Engineering Geologist License Number 1843 to Steven Richard Bond (Respondent). The Certified Engineering Geologist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation and will expire on February 29, 2024, unless renewed.

4. On or about September 29, 1995, the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists issued Certified Hydrogeologist License Number 238 to Steven Richard Bond (Respondent). The Certified Hydrogeologist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation and will expire on February 29, 2024, unless renewed.

JURISDICTION

5. This Accusation is brought before the Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists (Board), under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the Business and Professions Code (Code) unless otherwise indicated.

6. Code section 118, subdivision (b), provides that the suspension, expiration, surrender, or cancellation of a license shall not deprive the Board of jurisdiction to proceed with a disciplinary action during the period within which the license may be renewed, restored, reissued or reinstated.

STATUTORY PROVISIONS

7. Code section 7835 states:

All geologic plans, specifications, reports, or documents shall be prepared by a professional geologist or licensed certified specialty geologist, or by a subordinate employee under his or her direction. In addition, they shall be signed by the professional geologist or licensed certified specialty geologist and stamped with his or her seal, both of which shall indicate his or her responsibility for them.

8. Code section 7839.2, subdivision (a), states in pertinent part:

A professional geologist or professional geophysicist shall use a written contract when contracting to provide geological or geophysical services to a client pursuant to this chapter. The written contract shall be executed by the professional

geologist or professional geophysicist and the client or the client's representative prior to the professional geologist or professional geophysicist commencing work, unless the client states in writing that work may be commenced before the contract is executed.

9. Code section 7860 states, in pertinent part:

(a) The board may, upon its own initiative or upon the receipt of a complaint, investigate the actions of any professional geologist or geophysicist, and make findings thereon.

(b) By a majority vote, the board may publicly reprove, suspend for a period not to exceed two years, or revoke the certificate of any geologist or geophysicist registered hereunder, on any of the following grounds:

...

(3) Negligence or incompetence by a geologist or geophysicist in his or her practice.

...

(c) By a majority vote, the board may publicly reprove, suspend for a period not to exceed two years, or may revoke the certificate of any geologist or geophysicist registered under this chapter, for unprofessional conduct. Unprofessional conduct includes, but is not limited to, any of the following:

...

(2) Violating this chapter or any regulation adopted by the board pursuant to this chapter.

COST RECOVERY

10. Code section 125.3 provides, in relevant part, that the Board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case, with failure of the licentiate to comply subjecting the license to not being renewed or reinstated. If a case settles, recovery of investigation and enforcement costs may be included in a stipulated settlement.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

11. On or about September 18, 2020, Respondent sent an environmental adverse impact report to the City of Pacifica regarding the proposed development of eight townhouses (Vistamar Townhouse Project). On or about January 4, 2021, an attorney for the Vistamar Townhouse Project filed a complaint with the Board regarding Respondent's report.

1 **FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

2 (Negligence or Incompetence)

3 12. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 7860, subdivision
4 (b)(3), in that he was negligent or incompetent in his report. He erroneously claimed that the
5 project's retaining walls would create a dam that would back water up causing it to surface or
6 create buoyant forces that would lift buildings, and he also erroneously claimed that the
7 subsurface could produce thousands of gallons of water per minute.

8 **SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

9 (Failure to Sign and Seal Report)

10 13. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action for unprofessional conduct under Code
11 section 7860, subdivision (c)(2), in that he failed to sign and seal a report in violation of 7835. His
12 report to the City of Pacifica failed to include a seal.

13 **THIRD CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

14 (Failure to Have a Written Contract)

15 14. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action for unprofessional conduct under Code
16 section 7860, subdivision (c)(2), in that he failed to have a written contract. Respondent stated
17 that he only had an oral contract to provide his assessment and report to the City of Pacifica.

18 **PRAYER**

19 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters alleged in this
20 Accusation, and that following the hearing, the Board for Professional Engineers, Land
21 Surveyors, and Geologists issue a decision:

22 1. Revoking or suspending Professional Geologist License Number 5411, issued to
23 Steven Richard Bond;

24 2. Revoking or suspending Certified Engineering Geologist License Number 1843,
25 issued to Steven Richard Bond;

26 3. Revoking or suspending Certified Hydrogeologist License Number 238, issued to
27 Steven Richard Bond;

1 4. Ordering Steven Richard Bond to pay the Board for Professional Engineers, Land
2 Surveyors, and Geologists the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case,
3 pursuant to Code section 125.3; and,

4 5. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
